

Antigua March 31<sup>st</sup> 1809

That it is copy to all whom it may concern that we have this day agreed to divide the plantation belonging to us in Barbours and in which we now reside in, the following manner viz after being measured in three equal parts from the fence which separates it from the same or plantation lately belonging to Henry Wright to the limits on the west by a plantation belonging to Mr Elizabeth Tille Henry Taylor to have the Eastern part, Mr Taylor the middle and Richard Taylor the Western part, each part, having an equal interest in the dwelling house



That I William Sparks Planter in Brigis Conception Bay Newfoundland, and I Ambrose Sparks son of the above named William Sparks for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds lawful money of Great Britain which we acknowledge ourselves justly owing and indebted to Mark Buttonshier of Newca. do hereby for ourselves our heirs and assigns make over assign and convey to him the said Mark Buttonshier his heirs and assigns all our Right Title and Interest in and to a fishing town lying being and situated in Brigis aforesaid, which we now occupy and possess being the same as was previously occupied by John Sparks father of the said William Sparks, extending on the water side fifty nine yards bounded on the East by the line now in possession of James Harris deceased his Widow and on the West by the same in possession of Thomas Sparks also of William Sparks and I Ambrose Sparks do make over and convey unto Mark Buttonshier all movable property, chattels, and goods of whatever nature, sort or description, for the said debt due Mark Buttonshier. And we the aforesaid William Sparks and Ambrose Sparks having of ourselves good right, full power and lawful authority to sell, make over and convey the said property, hereby warrant and defend and agree hereafter to defend the said Mark Buttonshier in great possession of the same against the claims and demands of any persons persons whatever, to which we have herewith signed our hands and affixed our seals this twenty fifth day of November one thousand eight hundred and Twenty
